

Yale University Vaccination Requirements

Updated 15.11.2022

As of 15.11.22 Yale University requires all visitors on campus to be vaccinated against Covid 19. The following is a summary of the requirements that are currently in place, including the list of approved vaccines. Please check what these requirements mean for you, to make sure you comply and have provided proof of vaccination to ISSOS before travelling to Yale. We will update this information if any changes are made prior to summer.

Important: The rules below are specific to Yale University. It is your responsibility to check and make sure you comply with US government entry requirements, which may be different from Yale’s requirements that follow:

Are you Fully Vaccinated?

You are considered fully vaccinated when you are:

- 2 weeks (14 days) after your dose of an accepted single-dose vaccine, **OR**
- 2 weeks (14 days) after your second dose of an accepted 2-dose series, **OR**
- 2 weeks (14 days) after you received the full series of an accepted COVID-19 vaccine (not placebo) in a clinical trial, **OR**
- 2 weeks (14 days) after you received 2 doses of any “mix-and-match” combination of [accepted COVID-19 vaccines](#) administered at least 17 days apart

AND

- Have received any booster vaccines you are eligible for **in your home country for your age group**. If, based on your age, you are not yet eligible for boosters in your home country this is fine, as long as you have had a primary course detailed above.

Acceptable Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination

Documentation Type	Examples
Digital or Paper	Vaccination certificate with QR code, digital pass via Smartphone application with QR code (e.g., United Kingdom National Health Service COVID Pass, European Union Digital COVID Certificate), printout of Covid 19 vaccination record or vaccination certificate issued by an authorised vaccine provider (eg CDC vaccination card)

All forms of proof of COVID-19 vaccination must have:

- Personal identifiers (full name plus at least one other identifier such as date of birth or passport number) that match the personal identifiers on the passenger's passport or other travel documents
- Name of official source issuing the record (e.g., public health agency, government agency, or other authorised vaccine provider)
- Vaccine manufacturer and date(s) of vaccination

Again, it is your responsibility to check these requirements and make sure that you provide us with vaccination status for ISSOS at Yale. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to let us know.

Please also remember that it is your responsibility to check and make sure that you comply with all requirements for entry to the United States, which may differ from Yale's own requirements.
